Pastor's Desk**



This year of 2010 is special to me. I am 70 years old today (January 17) and I will be a priest serving you, my special folk, and the other people in our diocese for 43 years. God has truly blessed me to be your pastor.

Today's Gospel, The Wedding Feast of Cana, is one of my favorite biblical stories. Christ apparently ignores His mother's request to "rescue" the bridal party from embarrassment because there was no more wine. What does Mary do when her Son apparently refuses her request to help this couple? Does she nag Him until He agrees, or does she try to put a guilt trip on Him until He concedes to her request? No, she simply walks away and does not do anything; however, maybe she walks away and also silently and confidently prays to His (and our) Father.

God, our all loving, hearing, and attentive Father, thank you for giving me the opportunity to practice the gifts of patience and perseverance which my father, with his eighth grade Catholic education, taught me sixty years ago. It also must have worked for Mary, so let us follow her example. However, if we do not get what we pray for, then we should pray for the gift of the acceptance of God's will which, at that time, we totally and angrily do not understand.
