In 1948 my good friend, Charles "Dewey" Jubak and I read a little pamphlet in the back of St. Brendan's Church that said that Catholics were not allowed to belong to the YMCA (The Young Men's Christian Association) because we were Catholics, not Christians, and to belong to any Christian organization would be giving into religious indifference, which means one religion is as good as another.

"Dewey" and I walked out of the school in line, went down the street, and caught the #9 Mahoning Bus which took us downtown. After walking around town for about an hour we went into the "Y", purchased our yearly membership for \$8.00 and proceeded to play basketball, run around the indoor track and cooled off with a nice swim in the pool. After a refreshing shower we two eight year olds got dressed, went out, and caught the #9 Mahoning Bus and got home about 7:00 p.m. (Not bad for two eight year olds, ah?) Don't any of you third graders try to imitate this adventure?

I guess times have changed a little in the last 62 years because this Saturday Pastor Dan Vargo from the First United Methodist Church of Hubbard will be giving the homily at our 4:00 p.m. Mass and then I will be the guest homilist at his church at their Sunday 9:30 a.m. service.

Maybe, just maybe, St. Paul was "right on" in his epistle to the Corinthians which we hear today when he said, "Aren't we all members of the same body with Jesus, our Lord and Savior, as our head?"

God, our all loving and unifying Father, thank you for allowing us to see all people as our sisters and brothers and as members of the same loving, accepting, and forgiving body of Christ.
