WORDS FROM WORSHIPMINISTRY: (excerpt from "God is Love" Pope Benedict's First Encyclical)

"God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him" (1 Jn 4:16). These words from the First Letter of John express with remarkable clarity the heart of the Christian faith: the Christian image of God and the resulting image of mankind and its destiny. In the same verse, St. John also offers a kind of summary of the Christian life: 'We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us.' In these words the Christian can express the fundamental decision of his life. Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which give life a new horizon and a decisive direction. John's Gospel describes that event in these words: 'God so loved the world that he gave His only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.' (John 3:16)" Since God has first loved us (see 1Jn 4:10), love is now no longer a mere 'command': it is the response to the gift of love with which God draws near to us."
