### LENT

Lenten Regulations: During the season of Lent, Catholics traditionally observe the practices of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. With regard to the laws of fasting. **Catholics who are 18 years of age and not yet 60 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** The law of fast prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. In Addition, **Catholics 14 years of age and older** are to **abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Friday's of Lent.**
