On Holy Thursday Evening, April 1st after the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 pm we have a time of adoration until Midnight. To be sure that someone is there to "stay and keep watch" with our Lord, there will be a sign-up sheet in the back of the Church for 1/2 hour time frames starting at 9:00 pm. You are welcome and encouraged to be there for any or all of this time, but please sign-up for a specific time to assure we have someone there. ALSO, we will be praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 10:00 pm, so plan on being there and bring your rosary.

Good Friday - A day of fasting:

We are asked to fast on Good Friday and to continue fasting, if possible, all through Holy Saturday as strictly as we can so that we come to the Easter Vigil hungry and full of excitement, parched and longing to feel the sacred water of the font on our skin. Good Friday and Holy Saturday are days of paring down distractions so that we may be free for prayer and anticipation, for reflection, preparation, and silence. The Church is getting ready for the Great Night of the Easter Vigil.
