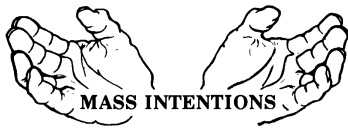

The power of the risen Christ shone through the apostles in spite of their weaknesses. After the resurrection their one concern was to imitate their Lord by doing good to others.

The result was that the number of men and women who came to believe in Jesus grew steadily. They were not drawing men to themselves but to Jesus. Sometimes they saw the fruit of their work, the success. Sometimes, as in the case of John, they had to suffer for it.

We also are servants of the risen Christ. We have the same privilege of trying to bring others to him. We may see results but we have been called to preach Christ by our lives. The Eucharist will increase his power in us.

Jn. 20:19-31. Jesus shows himself really alive. We cannot see him as the apostles did, but Jesus says: "Happy are they who have not seen, yet have believed."
