Soup Suppers



The Soup Suppers are served each of the Wednesdays of Lent (with the exception of Ash Wednesday) from 5:30-6:30PM in the Church Hall. A simple meal of soup with bread, crackers and a beverage is offered. There are many selections of soup each week which are all donated. The meal is free of charge but donations are accepted and are given to the Hubbard St. Vincent de Paul Society. It is a time of community fellowship which incorporates the Lenten themes of fasting (a simple meal), almsgiving (a donation) and even prayer (for those who stay after the Supper to celebrate Vespers which is the official Evening Prayer of the Church). The Soup Suppers are open to the public and all are welcome to attend. Much help is needed for these events since all soup, supplies and time are donated. Please consider helping by making your favorite soup and bringing it to the
