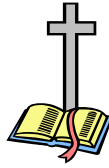


# *St. Patrick Parish Ministry Features*

## *Infant of Prague Guild*



*The Infant Jesus of Prague Guild in our Parish has a membership of ten people. The group is Pro-Life, supports the seminarians, the Byzantine Right, and the Holy Childhood Association. There have been Infant of Prague Guilds in the Diocese since Mrs. Garner, a member of St. Dominic Church in Youngstown, established the first one approximately sixty years ago. Each of the approximately twenty guilds in the Diocese takes turns hosting a monthly Diocesan Mass. There is an Anniversary Mass and Day of Reflection at which each Guild asks their Spiritual Advisor to concelebrate the Mass at the hosting church. Fr. Tim is the Spiritual Advisor for our Guild.
