Dear Friends,

" . . . although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned, you have revealed them to little ones."
Matthew 11: 25-30

THROUGH THE EYES OF "LITTLE ONES"

If you've ever worked with children or with someone who is physically or mentally challenged, you know how they can change your attitude and perspective. First-time parents quickly realize that their best teachers in how to parent are their children: their little ones help Mom and Dad realize the deep reservoir of love that they possess, love that enables them to give and teach and care for these young lives God has entrusted to them.

If you want to fully experience a zoo, the circus or a walk in the woods, take a child. Kids can make everything from petting a lamb to watching at a star shooting across the sky an awesome experience. Children see things with a sense of wonder and enthusiasm that reveals the joy in the simplest things and the beauty in what we "old folks" overlook or take for granted.

Many who have cared for someone living with a terminal illness, a chronic medical condition, or some physical or mental challenge have experienced moments when the caregiver became the "cared for," when the courage, determination and wisdom of the person they were assisting gave the caregiver a new perspective: they came to realize that the true value and meaning of life are found in the virtues of humility, generosity, selflessness, and mercy when these care providers found a new purpose and gratitude for the love they received as well as gave.

Children and those society deem as "little ones" have an uncanny ability to get to the heart of the matter. They can ask questions that make you take a new look at what you thought was pretty clear and straightforward; they approach things with an honesty and simplicity that cuts through the rationalizations and justifications we adults devise. Faith is neither "childish" nor pretends the world is a perfect fairy tale where everyone lives happily ever after. "Child-like" faith is focused on people rather than things, seeks what is right and good above all other considerations, cuts through the complexities we invoke to justify our self-interest. May the "child-like" in our lives open our eyes to the grace of God we often overlook.

As one passes by St. Patrick's, so many comment that it looks so beautiful, quiet and peaceful. However, let me assure you, St. Patrick's is a very busy, active place. St. Patrick's is a devout, active parish community celebrating Holy Mass, many parishioners dropping off items, tickets for the festival, so many phone calls or folks stopping by with so many different requests and needs handled by our parish staff. The rebuilding of our church is taking place with so many different trades working in the church and hall.

We are planning for a new year of ministry. Education and service is a priority as we live out our Christian calling. You are invited to be a part of our life together. How can you help and be an active member of the church family? Today the Gospel reminds us that the yoke of the Gospel of Jesus is easy in the joy it brings to the generous heart. It's made light by the love of God that we are able to bring into the lives we touch through our life as a parish.

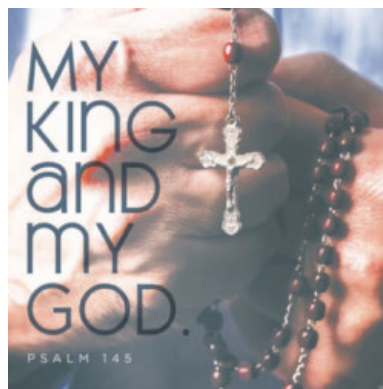
FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION CELEBRATION
