SEED PACKETS OF 26, 12 AND 10

Twenty-six. Every word we write and speak in English is made up of the same 26 letters. A great novel and a birthday card for your child are created from those same 26 letters. The first task in learning to read and write is mastering those 26 symbols and the sounds they represent.

Twelve. The number of notes on the musical scale: C, D, E, F, G, A and B, plus five flats and equivalent sharps between. For centuries, composers have worked these twelve tones into humanity's soundtrack. A Beethoven symphony, a Stephen Sondheim musical, a Beatle tune – all are created from the same 12 notes.

Ten. Actually the number of numbers is infinite, but ten is where we all start. Our adventures in math started with learning the numerals 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 and the quantities they represent. From there it was on to fractions and measurements, algebra and geometry. A few of us moved on to rocket science – but most of us manage to use those ten numbers (often with the help of a calculator) to balance our checkbooks, track our finances and measure whatever quantities we're working with.

The great events and moments of life begin with such "mustard seeds": simple, common symbols that we learn to create great works for the benefit of all. In today's Gospel, Jesus calls us to embrace a faith that is centered in the hope of life's mustard seeds: to realize the presence of God in the smallest, most hidden moments; to ignite a spark of God's light in the midst of unremitting darkness and pain; to reveal God's mercy in focused, visible ways, no matter how simple or small.

FROM THE DIOCESE OF YOUNGSTOWN

EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ALL

Every Ohio student in grades K-12 is now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic School tuition beginning with the upcoming 2023- 2024 school year. This will include currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic School experience this fall.

A full EdChoice Scholarship of \$6,165 for elementary and \$8,407 for high school is available for any family at or below 450% of the federal poverty level (ex. \$135,000 for a family of four). A decreasing pro-rated amount dependent on a family's economic status over 450% of the poverty level is then available, but the LEAST any child can receive is \$650 for an elementary student and \$950 for a high school student.

As soon as information on how to apply is available, families will be notified. Please stay tuned for more information regarding this exciting opportunity. doj.org
