AROUND THE TABLE

Very Rev. Michael A. Swierz, Pastor Second Sunday of Advent



Dear Friends.

A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths."

John the Baptist appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Mark 1: 1-8

CHRISTMAS WISHES

All she wants for Christmas is for her child to come home. She's the mother of a military service man or woman deployed in one of the many dangerous locales around the world. "Peace on earth" is her constant prayer.

His Christmas wish is to be reunited with his wife and son. For several months now they have been making the long, dangerous trek from their home in Venezuela to the United States. He came here two years ago to make enough money to send for them. Since they left, his life has been one long Advent of waiting and hoping that they arrive here safely.

Her only wish this Christmas is to have the energy to celebrate the holidays. This past year she's been undergoing treatment for an aggressive form of cancer. She has no illusions of expecting a miracle; she's not looking for a wonder drug. All she wants is to be able to be with her family, trim the tree, sing the songs, wrap the gifts, set up the family creche, and go to Christmas Mass again. All she asks is to make one more journey to Bethlehem.

We all want different things at Christmas. While some of us want to get through it on time with as little damage to our credit cards as possible, John the Baptizer challenges us to seek more from the Messiah's coming: a renewed sense of gratitude for the love, reconciliation with those from whom we are estranged; moving beyond the despair and brokenness in our lives to hope and wholeness; re-centering our lives on the things that give joy and fulfillment. May the next two weeks be about the work of Advent begun by John: to make a "way" of peace and hope for God to enter our homes and hearts in every place and season, to help one another realize their deepest Christmas wishes.

This weekend our second graders preparing for their First Holy Communion will celebrate the <u>Sacrament of Reconciliation for the very first time</u>. As they thought about what might happen this Sunday, they may have experienced emotions of apprehension, nervousness, fear and wonder. Their fear is normal when we have to

share with other persons our missed opportunities for love, forgiveness and honesty. Our world tells us over and over we have to be number one and that money, riches, strength and power are the road to success. Through it all, our parents try to stress the importance of making good choices, to get along with others and not to bully others. Our catechists, along with our deacons and myself teach that God is love and to serve others; God chooses the weak and makes them strong; God will always walk with us so don't be afraid.

As adults we hear the message of St. John the Baptist crying out, "Prepare the Way of the Lord". This advent season we are called to be ready, watchful and alert. We are called to have hope and live in peace. In the busyness of this Advent season I hope we can turn away from the anger, fear and the hurts of years gone by to learn from our past but to live for the future. If we are not awake or alert, God's presence and that grace-filled moment can pass us by. I pray that you celebrate the Baptist's words, "Prepare the Way of the Lord".

Thanks to all who have generously bought gifts for those in need. The Angel Tree, or Sharing Tree, is a beautiful tradition which celebrates this season of giving.

Next Sunday is Bambinelli Sunday. If possible, please bring the Infant Jesus from your Christmas crib or manger scene for a special blessing, linking church to home.
