Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As the day dawns today, we celebrate the **Fourth Sunday of Advent**. But as the sun begins to set we begin the **Vigil of the Nativity of the Lord, Christmas Eve**. So often we concentrate on the infant lying in the manger, as well as the shepherds, angels and wisemen. Our celebration of Christmas or the Nativity of Jesus focuses our attention on the wonder of God's desire to become one with humanity and all of creation. God becomes one of us so that we can become more like Him in our thoughts, words and actions.

On behalf of all who minister here in our parish, we extend our prayers and love as we begin our celebration of the Christmas season. The first Christmas was a family Christmas. Jesus is called **Emmanuel**, which means "**God with us**." Jesus was born to show us the way home, to forgive us, to heal us and undo the damage and brokenness our sin creates between God and us. Allow God to touch you in a special way this Christmas Season.

It is our hope that we may all be gathered together to praise our Savior on Christmas Day and to receive His unending gift of love. As we celebrate the **Nativity of our Lord**, we cast aside our cares and share in the joy of His Holy Birth.

We can give Jesus the greatest gift of love through caring for others during this special season and every day of our lives. Remember His words proclaiming that ". . . *As often as you did it for one of My least brothers, you did it for Me.*" In spreading the Good News and love to others, we are extending love to the Savior and practicing what He asks of us as children of God. Our actions of love can truly fill us with the spirit of Christmas. The door is open; His invitation given. **What is your response?**

As we gather in our prayer, share stories with family and friends, as we sing our traditional carols, let us always remember that first silent night, that holy night when God touched our human life so that we might again touch His. Let us pray for all of our family, friends and parishioners, those living and deceased, those we will see and those we will not see this holiday, that God will bless us each and every one.

May I be among the first to wish you and your family a very Merry Christmas and a Happy and Blessed New Year. Your support and cooperation during the past year is greatly appreciated. ***May you be filled with the wonder of Mary, the obedience of Joseph, the joy of the angels, the eagerness of the shepherds, the determination of the Magi, and the peace of the Christ-child. May God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit bless you always.***

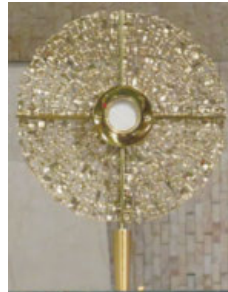

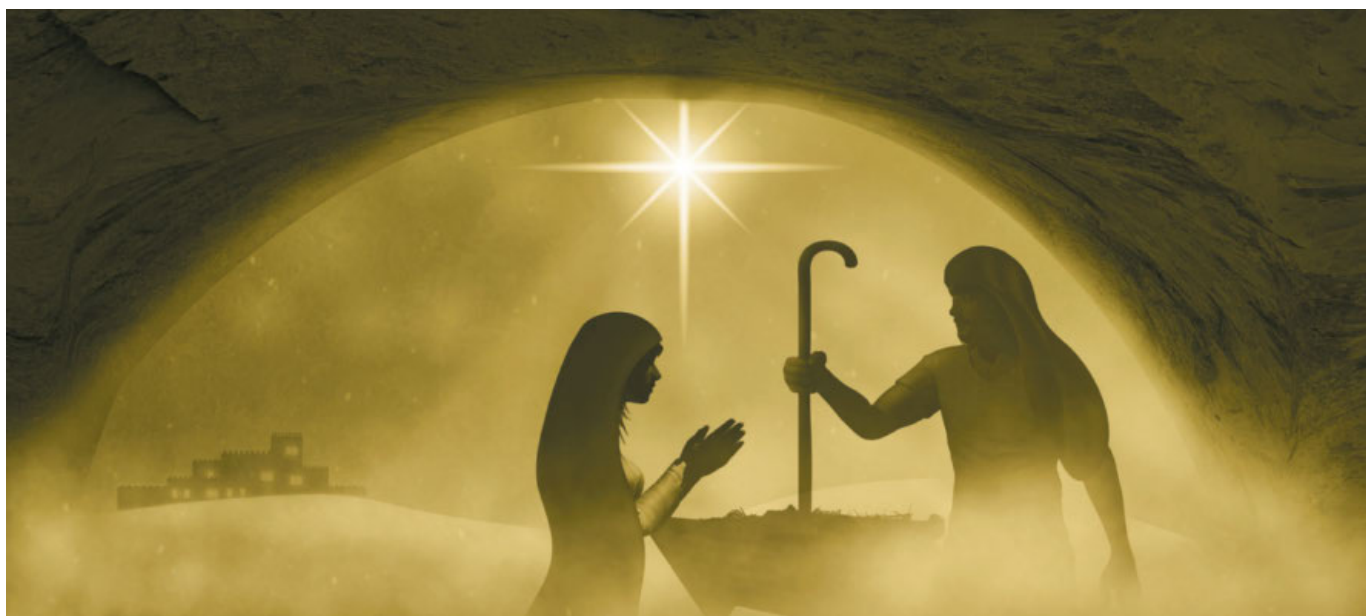
