

AROUND THE TABLE

Very Rev. Michael A. Swierz, Pastor Twenty-Sixth Sunday In Ordinary Time



Dear Friends,

As we gather as a parish family this weekend, you will notice a new prayer before we enter into the celebration of Holy Mass. We will be joining other parishes in praying the prayer asking the Holy Spirit to be upon the Holy Father and those gathered for the General Assembly, "For a Synodal Church, Communion, Participation, Mission."

Every session of the Second Vatican Council began with the Prayer *Adsumus Sancte Spiritus*, the first word of the Latin original meaning, "We stand before You, Holy Spirit," which has been historically used at Councils, Synods and other Church gatherings for hundreds of years, being attributed to Saint Isidore of Seville (c. 560—April 636). As we are called to embrace this synodal path of the Synod 2021-2023, this prayer invites the Holy Spirit to operate within us so that we may be a community and a people of grace.

As we begin this month of October, we begin a month dedicated to promoting a culture of life. This **Respect Life Month**, the Catholic Conference of Ohio firmly opposes Issue 1 which would enshrine the right to abortion in the Ohio Constitution. This amendment endangers the health and safety of women, threatens parental rights and allows for abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. The Church has always been a voice and advocate for the most vulnerable in society. You are invited to read more about Issue 1 by visiting https://www.ohiocathconf.org/.

During the month of October, we also pray in a special way through the intercession of Our Lady

of the Rosary before every Mass. Also, you <u>are invited</u> to pray the Holy Rosary with our parish family gathered on Saturday, Oct. 14, at 12 noon next to the parish <u>center</u>. All are welcome.

We will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at all Masses during the weekend of October 14 & 15. If you know of someone who is preparing for surgery, or in a special way would like to celebrate the sacrament, please invite them to pray and celebrate Holy Mass with us.

This week we will also celebrate the **Blessing of Pets in honor of St. Francis of Assisi on Wed., October 4**, 6:00 pm outside the parish center.


